**Chancellor's Report**  
Arkansas State University-Mountain Home

1. Enrollment

Based on a report in the *Community College Week* we rank 31<sup>st</sup> in the country in enrollment growth in colleges below 2,500 students. This report was for the fall of 2008. Fall 2009 was even better and our projection for growth this spring is excellent.

2. Higher Education Holdings (HEH)

3. State Funding per Degrees
