<p><b>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b></p>	<p><a href="#">In-Network providers</a>                      \$1,000 individual / \$2,000 family  <a href="#">Out-of-network providers</a>                      \$2,000 individual / \$4,000 family</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a>, each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a>.</p>
<p><b>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b></p>	<p>Yes. Telehealth services by MDLIVE and the following <a href="#">In-Network providers</a>: physician office services, <a href="#">preventive care</a>, chiropractic care, allergy and physician visit /office services and pharmacy charges are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>.</p>	<p>This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	Yes. This <a href="#">plan</a> uses a provider <a href="#">network</a> . You will pay less if you use a <a href="#">provider</a> in the plan's <a href="#">network</a> . You will pay the most if you use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> , and you might receive a bill from a <a href="#">provider</a> for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <a href="#">plan</a> pays ( <a href="#">balance billing</a> ). Be aware, your <a href="#">network provider</a> might use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <a href="#">provider</a> before you get services.
Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	No.	You can see a <a href="#">specialist</a> without a <a href="#">referral</a> .

**Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**

**This is not a cost estimator.** Treatments shown are just examples of how this [plan](#) might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your [providers](#) charge, and many other factors. Focus on the [cost-sharing](#) amounts ([deductibles](#), [copayments](#) and [coinsurance](#)) and [excluded services](#) under the [plan](#). Use this information to compare the portion of costs you might pay under different health [plans](#). Please note these coverage examples are based on self-only coverage.

### Peg is Having a Baby

(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)

### Mia's Simple Fracture

(in-network emergency room visit and follow up care)

- Hospital (facility) [coinsurance](#) \$200 + 20%
- Other [coinsurance](#) 20%
